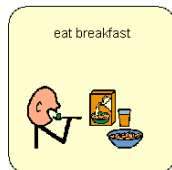


Boardmaker



Boardmaker software is available in 25 libraries across Leeds

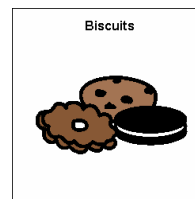
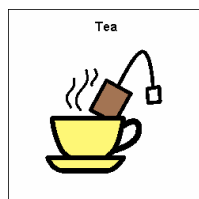
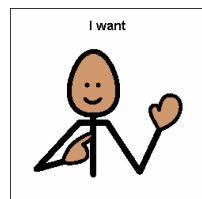
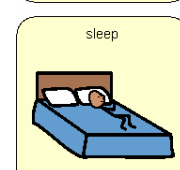
Boardmaker has thousands of symbols that can be printed and used to support visual communication



Symbols can be used as visual reminders or to help people who have difficulties that affect their speech

You can book sessions with a librarian to learn how to use Boardmaker, then use it independently to print your symbols

Each library has a laminator to laminate your boards and symbols after printing

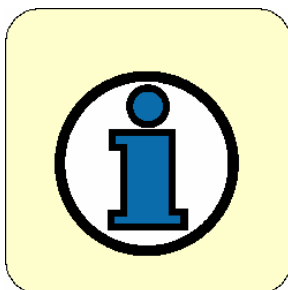
